

1. The Coffey County Commissioners met in adjourned session on Thursday, January 27, 2000. Chairman Gene Merry called the meeting to order at 8:35 a.m. with members Johnnie Sleezer, Tim Sipe, Bill Knapp, and Perry Powell present. County Clerk Vernon Birk was also present.
2. The Board questioned and signed warrants and vouchers for the month of January.
3. JoAnn Raaf, Coffey County Treasurer, reported the Motor Vehicle Department, Department of Revenue, has replaced the 2 state printers in her office with 2 new laser printers.
4. Jon Hotaling, Economic Development Director, discussed Economic Development issues with the Board.
- 4 a. Sleezer moved to appoint Jon Hotaling to serve as the Coffey County Representative on the Executive Committee of the Southeast Kansas Regional Planning Commission, seconded by Sipe. Motion carried. The appointment is for the year 2000.
5. At approximately 10:05 a.m. Kenny Roney, Undersheriff, opened bids for 10 replacement mobile radar units. Bids presented:
