The Coffey County Commission Chambers opened at 8:30 a.m. Tuesday, April 1, 2003 to conduct a salary work session for setting classified employees wages for April 2003 through the end of March 2004. Chairman Gene Merry called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. with members R. Kraig Kirchner, Tim Sipe, Fred Rowley, Jr. and Larry Crofts present. 6. The Sheriff requested a 10-minute Executive Session.

7. Gwen Birk, Coffey County Register of Deeds, met with the Board to discuss her proposed Form CP-5. After discussion the Board approved a revised Form CP-5, a lower amount than submitted.
8. Crofts moved to adjourn the meeting at 11:53 a.m., seconded by Kirchner. Motion carried.
