

1. The Coffey County Commission met in adjourned session on Friday, April 6, Chairman Gene Merry called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m. with members Tim Sipe, Fred Rowley, Jr., Johnnie Sleezer and Larry Crotts present. Also present were County Clerk/Election Officer Vernon Birk, County Attorney Doug Witteman and Deputy Elections Officer Jackie Hawley.
2. The Coffey County Commissioners convened as a Board of Canvassers to canvass the results of the April 3, 2001 General Election. The County Election Officer presented the original returns, together with all other official records of the election, to the Canvass Board for the purpose of canvass. The County Election Officer gave a brief overview of the election.
  - 2 a. Sleezer moved, upon the recommendation of the County Election Officer, to accept 7 provisional ballots and to reject 3 provisional ballots, consistent with state statutes and to add the accepted ballots to the appropriate vote totals for the April 3, 2001 City/School General Election, seconded by Merry. Motion carried.
  - 2 b. Crotts moved, upon the recommendation of the County Election Officer, to sign the official record book listing the results of the April 6, 2001 canvass of the April 3, 2001 City/School General Election, seconded by Sipe. Motion carried.
3. Sipe moved to adjourn the meeting at 9:25 a.m., seconded by Sleezer. Motion carried.
