

1. Commission Chairman Gene Merry signed a Proclamation of a State of Local Disaster Emergency at 8:53 a.m. for the county of Coffey, Kansas. Commissioner Merry left shortly thereafter for another appointment.
2. Coffey County Commissioners Tim Sipe, Larry Crotts, and Johnnie Sleezer met at 9:00 a.m., April 11, 2001, in the Emergency Operating Center at the Emergency Preparedness Coordinator's request to be advised of the damage in Coffey County from an early morning storm with strong winds.
3. Wind damage was experienced throughout Coffey County. LeRoy and Gridley cities have no power at this time. Reports from KG&E spokespersons are that it will not be restored until late tonight.
4. The Proclamation will make Coffey County resources available to help with emergencies and to repair the damages, etc.
5. It appears the immediate concern is to find an electric generator for LeRoy City.
6. Also in attendance were Becky Jewett, Emergency Preparedness Coordinator, Jeff Beyer, Radiological Officer/Assistant Coordinator, Doug Witteman, Coffey County Attorney, Randy Rogers, Coffey County Sheriff, and Kenny Roney, Coffey County Undersheriff, and Mark Petterson.
