

1. The Coffey County Commission Chambers opened at 8:00 a.m. Monday, April 25, 2007, to allow commissioners to individually review correspondence. Chairman Tim Sipe called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. with members Larry Crotts, Fred Rowley, Jr., Kimberly Robrahn and Bob Saueressig present. Also present were Angie Kirchner, County Clerk, and Donna Berland, Administrative Assistant.

2. The Board questioned and signed checks and vouchers for the month of April 2007.

3. The Board will look into establishing a policy on attending funerals and taking County vehicles versus employees receiving mileage for attending funerals.

4. The Board discussed the siren in Lebo with Emergency Preparedness Coordinator Becky Jewett. The Board inquired if the wireless signal is not reaching Lebo, then can the company install a land line to activate the Lebo siren. The Board wants to know a new total package cost with new sirens, connection and maintenance. Jewett stated that she would look into pricing on a new package by next Monday, April 30th, 2007, at 10:00 a.m. Jewett stated that Wolf Creek Nuclear Operating Corporation (WCNOC) will have all of their new sirens in place and ready to go by September 2007. The Board wanted to know if the County purchased 2 new sirens and new company installed them if the company would guarantee the sirens to work. Jewett will return to the meeting next week with more information.

5. Robrahn moved to reject all vehicle bids for the 2007 or 2008 (7) passenger vehicle. No bids met specifications, seconded by Rowley. Motion carried.

6. Sipe adjourned the meeting at 12:06 p.m.
