

- 1.** The Coffey County Commission Chambers opened at 8:00 a.m. Wednesday, June 27, 2007. Chairman Tim Sipe called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. with members Larry Crotts, Fred Rowley, Jr., Kimberly Robrahn and Bob Saueressig present. Also present was Angie Kirchner, County Clerk.
- 2.** The Board questioned and signed warrants and vouchers for the month of June 2007.
- 3.** The Board authorized the County Clerk to not go forward with the process for requesting bids for hands free toilet flushers and hands free faucets for the courthouse. With a decrease in the County valuation, the purchase of hands free toilet flushers and hands free faucets would be an unnecessary purchase at this time. The recommendation was originally made in 2006 by the Health Department Administrator in the event of a Pandemic Flu outbreak and to assist in the prevention of the spreading of colds and viruses.
- 4.** The Board authorized the County Clerk to look into costs for purchasing automatic light switches to assist in the conservation of energy costs for the courthouse.
- 5.** County Engineer Wayne Blackbourn met with the Board to discuss the development of frontage roads near the BETO Junction area. Blackbourn also gave an update on the construction that the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) will be providing.
- 6.** Sipe adjourned the meeting at 12:05 p.m.
