

1. The Coffey County Commission Chambers opened at 8:00 a.m., Wednesday, August 10, 2016. Chairman Arlin Meats called the special meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. with members Jim Dale, Kenneth Combes and Bob Saueressig present. County Clerk Angie Kirchner and Administrative Assistant Donna Berland were also present. Fred Rowley was absent.
2. Combes moved to appoint Register of Deeds Gwen Birk as a Canvasser to canvass the results of the August 2nd, 2016 Primary Election, seconded by Dale. Motion carried.
3. Birk moved to convene as a Board of Canvassers to canvass the results of the August 2nd, 2016 Primary Election, at 9:01 a.m., seconded by Saueressig. Motion carried.
4. County Clerk/Election Officer Angie Kirchner met with the Board to request the Board re-certify the results of the August 2nd, 2016, Primary Election. Kirchner explained that after the provisional ballots were added to the totals there was a write-in missed that needed to be added to a Pottawatomie Township Trustee write-in. This caused a tie between David Kunkel with 3 votes and Kent Stukey with the additional 3rd vote.
5. County Election Officer Angie Kirchner presented the provisional write-in tally sheets of the 2016 Primary Election to the County Board of Canvassers for the purpose of canvassing the records.
6. Dale moved to re-certify the results of the Canvass Board, seconded by Combes. Motion carried.
7. Saueressig moved to adjourn the Canvass Board at 9:09 a.m. and reconvene as a Board of County Commissioners, seconded by Birk. Motion carried.
8. Meats recessed the special meeting at 9:10 a.m., until Friday at 9:00 a.m. to canvass the requested recount on the Democrat 76th District race as required by K.S.A. 25-3107.
