

1. The Coffey County Commission Chambers opened at 8:00 a.m., Friday, August 12, 2016. Chairman Arlin Meats called the special meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. with members Jim Dale, Fred Rowley, Kenneth Combes and Bob Saueressig present. County Clerk Angie Kirchner and Administrative Assistant Donna Berland were also present.
2. Saueressig moved to appoint Register of Deeds Gwen Birk as a Canvasser to canvass the results of the August 11th, 2016 Primary Election recount on the Democrat 76th District race as required by K.S.A. 25-3107, seconded by Combes. Motion carried.
3. Combes moved to convene as a Board of Canvassers to canvass the results of the August 11th, 2016 Primary Election recount on the Democrat 76th District, at 9:01 a.m., seconded by Dale. Motion carried.
4. County Election Officer Angie Kirchner presented the recount tally sheets of the 2016 Primary Election recount of the Democrat 76th District to the County Board of Canvassers for the purpose of canvassing the records. Kirchner said that the recount came out exactly as she reported at the canvass on Monday, August 8th with Kelly Atherton at 131 and Teresa Briggs at 120. Kirchner said Vic Miller and Kelly Atherton were present as Poll Agents during the entire recount. Kirchner also stated that she was confident her election was accurate.
5. Birk moved to certify the results of the Canvass Board, seconded by Saueressig. Motion carried.
6. Birk moved to adjourn the Canvass Board at 9:05 a.m. and reconvene as a Board of County Commissioners, seconded by Dale. Motion carried.
7. Meats adjourned the special meeting at 9:06 a.m.
