

The Coffey County Commission met in adjourned session on Friday, November 10, 2000. Chairman Gene Merry called the meeting to order at 8:12 a.m. with members Tim Sipe, and Johnnie Sleezer present. Commissioner's Perry Powell and Bill Knapp were unable to attend due to another commitment. Also present, Vernon Birk, Coffey County Elections Officer and Doug Witteman, County Attorney.

The Coffey County Commissioners convened as a Board of Canvassers to canvass the results of the November 7, 2000 General Election. The County Election Officer presented the original returns, together with all other official records of the election to the Canvass Board for the purpose of canvass. The County Election Officer gave a brief overview of the election.

Sipe moved to recess the canvass until Monday, November 13, 2000, seconded by Sleezer. Motion carried.

Sleezer moved to authorize and direct the Chairman to sign the Consent by and between Palmetto Holdings, L.L.C. and Andrew Corporation for property located in the City of Burlington, known as Lot 1, Block 1, Industrial Park #2, First Plat.

Sleezer moved to adjourn the meeting at 8:33 a.m., seconded by Sipe. Motion carried.
