

1. The Coffey County Commission Chambers opened at 8:00 a.m., Thursday, November 15, 2012. Vice Chairman Kenneth Combes called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. with members Bob Saueressig and Fred Rowley present to canvass the results of the 2012 General Election. County Clerk/Election Officer Angie Kirchner, County Payroll Clerk Denise Humlicek and County Attorney Doug Witteman were also present for the meeting. Kimberly Skillman-Robrahn and Larry Crotts were absent from the meeting.
2. Rowley moved to appoint Register of Deeds Gwen Birk and Treasurer Brenda Cherry as members of the Board of Canvassers to canvass the results of the 2012 General Election, seconded by Saueressig. Motion carried.
3. Saueressig moved to convene as a Board of Canvassers to canvass the results of the November 6, 2012 General Election, at 9:00 a.m., seconded by Rowley. Motion carried.
4. Saueressig moved, upon the recommendation of the County Election Officer, to accept 55 provisional ballots, and reject 25 provisional ballots, consistent with state statues, and provisional vote totals will be added to the appropriate races, seconded by Combes. Motion carried.
5. County Election Officer Angie Kirchner presented the poll books and tally sheets of the General Election to the County Board of Canvassers for the purpose of canvassing the records.
6. The Board reviewed and initialed the tally sheets and poll books for the write-in votes.
7. The Board reconvened as a Board of County Commissioners at 10:04 a.m. and Birk and Cherry left the meeting.
8. The County Thanksgiving Dinner will be Friday, November 16th at the 4-H Building at Kelley Park from 11:30 a.m. until 1:00 p.m.
9. Combes recessed the meeting at 10:04 a.m., until Friday, November 16th at 9:30 a.m. to meet with Kansas Department of Commerce Representative Craig VanWey to discuss the Economic Development position, and to discuss any other County business that may arrive.
