

RESOLUTION NO. 2020- 852-A

**COVID -19 LOCAL PUBLIC HEALTH  
EMERGENCY RESOLUTION – EXTENDED**

WHEREAS, now on this 13th day of July, 2020, the Board of County Commissioners of Coffey County, Kansas, had previously declared there was a state of local public health emergency in Coffey County, Kansas, on March 16, 2020, resulting in potential or occurring pandemic known as COVID 19, in Coffey County, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, such conditions continue to endanger the public health, safety and welfare of persons within the borders of Coffey County, Kansas.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Coffey County, Kansas:

That the state of local public health emergency in Coffey County, Kansas was initially declared on the 16th day of March, 2020, and was to continue and remain in effect for a duration of 60 days unless terminated earlier.

That a subsequent COVID 19 emergency resolution was again approved by the Board of County Commissioners of Coffey County on May 18, 2020 resulting in the continuation of a state of local public health emergency in Coffey County, Kansas. The May 18, 2020 emergency resolution was to continue and remain in effect until July 16, 2020 unless modified or terminated earlier. This emergency resolution has remained in effect for the entirety of the 60 days due to the continuing and ongoing state of local public health emergency in Coffey County, Kansas.

Presently, the state of local public health emergency in Coffey County, Kansas, continues to remain an ongoing local public health emergency and it is necessary and prudent to extend said local public health emergency beyond the July 16, 2020 end date.


Based on the recommendations of local and state officials, the state of local public health emergency in Coffey County, Kansas shall continue and remain in effect indefinitely and said state of local public health emergency shall continue in full force and effect until otherwise terminated or modified by subsequent resolution or by the Board or in any other manner prescribed by law.

That the response and recovery aspects of all local disaster plans which are applicable to Coffey County, Kansas and shall initiate and continue the rendering of aid and assistance there under.


That any rights or powers lawfully exercised or any actions taken pursuant to local disaster emergency plans shall continue and have full force and effect as authorized by law indefinitely and said state of local public health emergency shall continue in full force and effect until otherwise terminated or modified by subsequent resolution or by the Board or in any other manner prescribed by law.

I DO HEREBY INVOKE any and all rights and/or powers to perform such functions as are vested in this office by and through the provisions of the Kansas Emergency Preparedness Act.


